SEPTA BUS ROUTE



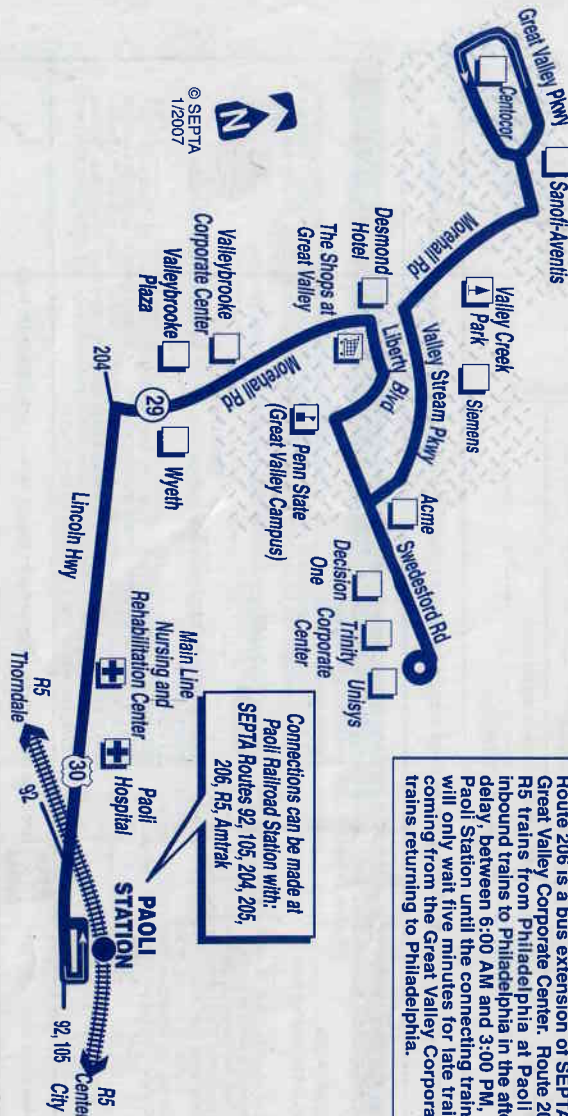

ROUTE 206 IS A BUS THAT IS LIKE A TRAIN

Route 206 is a bus extension of SEPTA Regional Rail service to the Great Valley Corporate Center. Route 206 is scheduled to meet Route R5 trains from Philadelphia at Paoli Station in the morning and inbound trains to Philadelphia in the afternoon. In the event of a train delay, between 6:00 AM and 3:00 PM, Route 206 buses will wait at Paoli Station until the connecting trains arrive. After 3:00 PM buses will only wait five minutes for late trains in order to provide riders coming from the Great Valley Corporate Center timely transfers to trains returning to Philadelphia.

Effective October 1, 2007 and subject to change.

BASE FARE\$2.00 ZONE FARES.....each 50¢

Advance Purchase Alternatives For The Base Fare:

TOKEN (sold in 2, 5 and 10 packs).....\$1.45

TRANSPASS (A TransPass is valid for a one zone ride on any transit route. Transit routes with multiple fare zones require a 50¢ payment for each additional zone traveled beyond the first zone. The TransPass is also valid for travel between Center City Stations on Regional Rail, and Center City Stations and R1 to the Airport at all times. A weekly or monthly TransPass is also valid for off-peak travel (consult Regional Rail timetables) on Regional Rail entirely within the City of Philadelphia. TransPasses have "Anywhere" privileges on Saturdays, Sundays and major holidays.)

TRAILPASS (A TrailPass has all the privileges of a TransPass, and includes transit zone fares and Regional Rail travel up to the zone purchased. TrailPasses have "Anywhere" privileges on Saturdays, Sundays and major holidays)

CROSS COUNTY PASS (A Cross County pass is valid for all transit and Regional Rail service outside the City of Philadelphia. An additional 50¢ charge is needed to board transit vehicles within the City of Philadelphia or the first fare zone. The Cross County pass has "Anywhere" privileges on Saturdays, Sundays and major holidays.)

CONVENIENCE PASS (good for up to 8 trips on any single day and includes zone fares).....MONTHLY.....\$96.00

TRANSFER.....75¢

SENIOR CITIZEN FARE (With valid Medicare Card, Pennsylvania Senior Citizen ID Card or Railroad Retirement Card).....FREE

DISABLED FARE (With valid Medicare Card or Pennsylvania Reduced Transit ID Card).....75¢ base fare/30¢ Transfer/25¢ each Zone

OFF-PEAK (including Saturdays, Sundays and major holidays).....75¢ base fare/30¢ Transfer/25¢ each Zone
PEAK HOURS (Monday to Friday, 7:00 AM to 8:00 AM and 4:30 PM to 5:30 PM).....Token or \$2.00, 75¢ Transfer
CHILD 42" TALL AND LESS (Up to 2 free at all times with a fare paying adult. On Saturdays, Sundays and certain holidays up to 2 additional children eleven years of age and younger with a fare paying adult travel at \$1.00 each way per child regardless of the zone of origin.)
